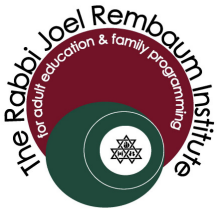

WHY DARFUR?

Darfur is a region in Western Sudan in Africa that is host to the 21st century's 1st genocide. Since 2003, more than 400,000 people have been killed and as many as 2.9 million people have been displaced from their homes by fighting. 4.9 million people currently need humanitarian aid, including large numbers of school-aged children.

WHAT IS JEWISH WORLD WATCH (JWW)?
